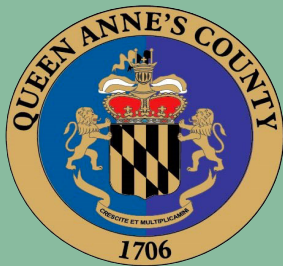

NEED A RIDE?

Whether you do not own a car, cannot drive, or just need a ride, we can help. Delmarva Community Transit (DCT) and Queen Anne's County County Ride (QACCR) provide transportation throughout the Mid-Shore area at very affordable rates.

We cover the Eastern Shore

DCT and QACR cover Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's and Talbot Counties, with regularly scheduled route service Monday through Friday, plus limited Saturday Service. For seniors over 60 years of age, and people with disabilities, we provide demand response service with 24 hour notice.

To work, shopping, medical appointments, etc.

If you need to travel throughout the Mid-Shore area, DCT and QACCR can provide bus service to get you there and bring you home.

Fully equipped buses

Need a lift? We can literally pick-you-up—including your wheel chair or power chair—thanks to the “lift” capabilities on many of our buses. Our drivers pay particular attention to riders needing extra help. When you call for “on-demand” service let us know of any limitations you have so we can meet your needs. On regularly scheduled trips, explain any special needs to the driver picking you up. Our drivers are trained to help with special needs.

Not comfortable taking the bus?

That's no problem. We can provide a “Travel Trainer” to help you “learn the ropes.” The travel trainer will literally ride with you while you are becoming accustomed to using our bus system. They'll take you step-by-step through the entire process, all at no extra charge.
